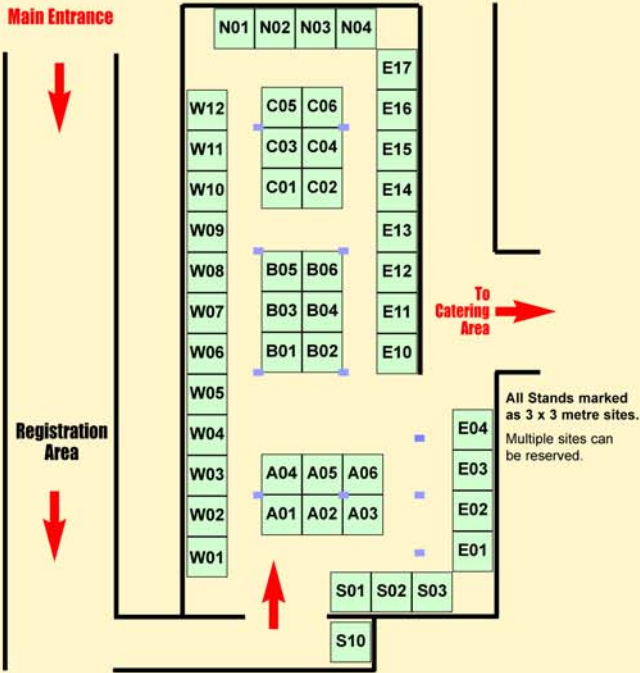

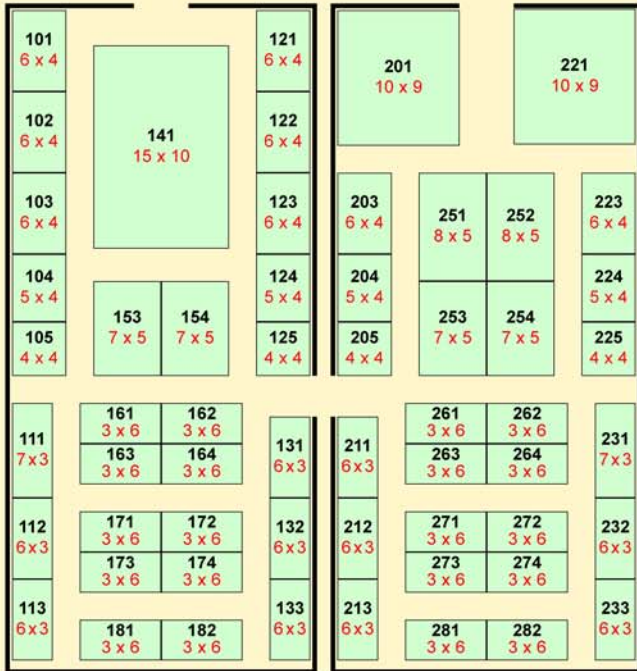
FLOOR PLAN

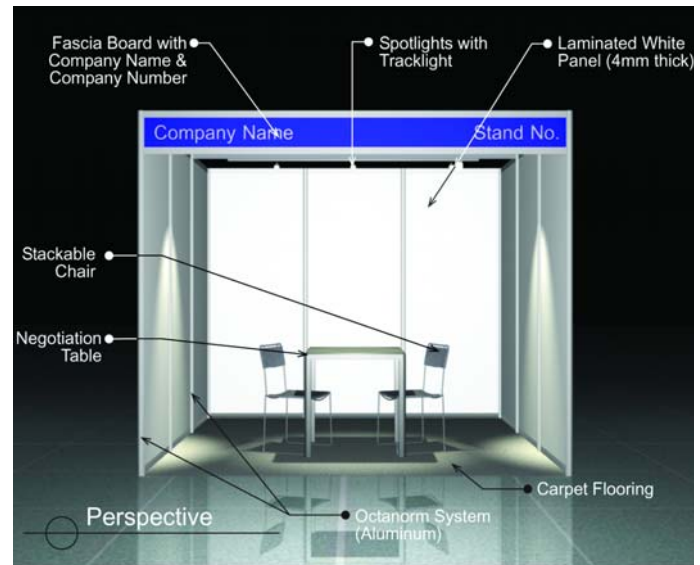
